The 3rd of October 2021, our church said farewell to the family that started this ministry over thirty-eight years ago in their home. **It was a privilege to serve with Tom and Sandy Hastings for almost thirteen years.** The Hastings mean a great deal to me and our church. We are already finding ways to have them visit us next year during the summer.



About seven years ago, I met a young German man named **Thomas**. After losing contact with him for about four years he recently attended our church services in October. After the service, he let me know that **he had recently accepted Jesus in his heart a few days before coming to church.** I had spent over three years witnessing to him. I'm looking forward to baptizing him in the Rhein River in a few months. We plan on disciplining soon.

We recently had our Fall VBS. Even with strict COVID regulations we had almost forty kids in attendance. Our VBS is always a highlight for our church kids to invite lost friends to church. Covid regulations have created a certain degree of difficulty for future church events. Through it all, God has blessed our church. In November, our church took on two new members. These new members had been attending services faithfully for over six months. In recent days, I have held two funerals. Both of the funerals had lost loved ones in attendance. In the last year, God has been working on the hearts of our church men. As of now, I have six different men lined up to preach regularly. Last year we had four men from our church preach atleast three times in the year. God blessed our Christmas service with over one hundred and thirty in attendance. **Please pray for a young man named Matthias, he is not saved and is seeking the truth.**
