Discovering the New Normal

Returning to FCC's pre-COVID format continues to be a challenge, as COVID-variants rise. The Delta variant has thrown a few monkey wrenches

into our plans, but not enough to deter us. As many of you know firsthand, breakthrough infections for vaccinated individuals continue plus children under 12 remain unable to receive any vaccinations. Thankfully, these obstacles cannot thwart the faith, resolve, or adaptability of our church leaders. With the Holy Spirit's guidance, they are adapting to these constantly changing times -- discovering the New Normal!

As such, our leaders remain firmly committed to resuming FCC's original Sunday format: 2 Services at 8:30 & 10:30, Sunday school at 9:30, and Fellowship groups in late afternoons & evenings – beginning Sunday, September 12. To do so *safely*, our original "return to church" plans required modifications.
