Open and Affirming Survey

One Week Left! Ends Sunday, May 22

For the past few years, the congregation of FCC has been exploring and learning about becoming an Open and Affirming congregation. This week marks the final week of our congregation-wide survey regarding the Welcome Statement, that was recently approved by our Elders and our Administrative Board for a congregational vote. This Welcome Statement reads:

At First Christian Church our mission is to know God and follow Jesus Christ, who calls us to be an Open and Affirming, inclusive faith community. We celebrate God's boundless and unconditional love by intentionally welcoming and affirming all people, as God embraces us. We welcome persons of every age, sexual orientation, gender identity, race, ethnicity, nationality, ability, relationship status, family structure, economic status, and educational level into the full life of our congregation. Our paths may differ, but we journey in faith together. Wherever you are on life's journey, you are welcome!

This brief, anonymous congregational survey consists of one question - "If you were to vote on whether to approve this statement today, would you vote yes or no?" The purpose of this step is to assess the congregation to ensure there is strong support before moving forward. If there is strong support (at least 75% in favor), that suggests the congregation is ready to take the next step of holding an official congregational vote.


