

Additional COVID precautions...

- Weather permitting, we will **remain outside** as much as possible, with the exception of Openings in Room 208 and one Marketplace station.
- **Social distancing** will be practiced and encouraged throughout the morning.
- Stations will have hand sanitizer as will Crew/Pod Leaders.
- Children and staff will **sanitize or wash hands** before *every* station rotation.
- Check in volunteers will wear **masks**. All other volunteers will wear masks or face shields only when indoors. Masks for children are mandatory indoors for elementary children, but are optional outdoors. Masks for preschool children will be mandatory only during gathering time in room 208 and are optional all other times. Extra masks will be available if needed.
- Games will be **non-contact** and equipment will not be shared.
- Parents will be notified immediately if a child starts feeling unwell.

Last but not least...

Crews or Pods

- Kids will remain in their **pre-assigned Crews/Pods**—meeting registration friend requests and CDC ratios. Please prepare your child to be excited about their crew, no changes.
- **First and Last name are on your child's student bag**, in case it gets misplaced. Kids will use these bags to carry their daily supplies (towel, water, epi-pens, inhalers, etc.). These bags will remain at the church until the program ends. Crew leaders will have matching bags. **Please send a towel with your child on the first day of Summer Kids in Faith!**

Daily Information

Drop-off:

Please read **carefully**:

- Sign in your child at the KidCheck sign-in stations. Or, use the church app for rapid sign-in at the Preschool or Elementary areas.
- **Preschool/Nursery KidCheck sign-in** will be located at the nursery on the first floor. Please drop-off all preschool students at the nursery door where crew leaders will greet them.
- **Elementary KidCheck Sign-in** will be located at the second-floor lobby area at the top of the stairs. Please sign in children with their "going into" grades. Crew leaders will be there to greet children, give out back packs, etc.... and walk them to room 208.
- Drop off time will be **10 minutes prior to praise service start-up time** for all students.
- **Arrive** ten minutes prior to service start-up, as **programming starts promptly** on the hour. If you arrive late, you will find us in room 208, or the North field outside the preschool doors.

PICK-UP:

- **Pick-up all students at the same location as drop-off following the praise service.**

What to bring EACH Sunday to Kids in Faith:

- **Beach Towel:** This will be your child's '*sit-on spot*' so we can properly distance our kids. Please label with child's name.
- **Water Bottle:** Please have children bring water bottles labeled with their names.
- **Sunscreen:** Please apply sunscreen **at home**. **Also**, any bug spray.
- **Prescribed Medication** or Epi Pen if required. Especially for bee sting allergies. We will place these in child's bag each week.
- **There will be no snacks at Kids in Faith**

Wellness Policy

At **Medina UMC**, we strive to provide a healthy environment for all and ask those experiencing symptoms of communicable illnesses refrain from in-person activities.

Due to COVID19, we can't emphasize enough the importance of following our wellness policy. If in the last 14 days, you or someone you are bringing, have been told to quarantine by a medical or government official, had a fever, or a persistent dry cough or shortness of breath, we ask that you please stay home. We appreciate your care and consideration for others.

If you or one of your children are experiencing *any* of the below symptoms of communicable illnesses, we ask that you to please *keep them at home*.

- Fever (100.4°F or higher) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Green nasal discharge
- Unexplainable rash
- Watery, matted eyes
- Head lice (those with head lice can only return to church after being treated with a lice killing medication and no live lice are seen and all nits are removed.)
