OUR SERVICES

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The Gift of Love Center Food Pantry remains open. Special procedures are in effect to allow for the recommended social distancing. Face masks are required of everyone on our premises. Food is distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis. Although registration is not required, you may be asked to present a current photo ID.

WALK-UP SERVICE

Walk-up clients must wear face masks that cover the nose and mouth and maintain the recommended social distance. Member volunteers will provide touchless distribution service.

CURBSIDE SERVICE

Curbside service is available for clients with limited mobility or who prefer to drive. All persons must remain in the vehicle with the windows rolled up; otherwise, masks are required. Member volunteers will place food items in the trunk of your car or the truck bed of your truck.
