March 2019 - We have started off 2019 with salvation decisions, baptisms, additions to the church and returning visitors. We seem to be experiencing some growth. We are so very grateful to God for making it all possible. There are links in the side bar to videos and pics on page 2.

Trisha was baptized on March 10, 2019. She is a teenager from the Philippines. Her mother has lived in Ireland for several years and was finally able to bring Trisha to Ireland in the summer of 2017. Trisha attended our church for a whole year because her parents asked her. She was not much interested in the Bible. In July 2018, her mother encouraged her to help us with the kids in Summer Bible Camp. As she helped make sure the children behaved during the class, she heard the gospel explained very clearly. She said that as the memory verse John 3:16 was explained she finally had her "Aha!" moment. That verse arrested her attention. She really listened to the children's lessons. She also attended the teen rally in the evenings that week and listened once again very closely. A few weeks after the Bible Camp, Dan asked her about her faith. This led to a conversation in which she accepted Christ as her Saviour. She now attends church because she wants to and listens to the messages because she sees how much they can help her in her daily life.

Sam grew up unsaved in a liberal church in the UK and drifted in University. In the spring of 2018, he was hired by a software company in Dublin. After he attended the church, Dan presented the gospel to him. He faithfully attended church and was saved a few months later. He was baptized and joined the church on March 10th. He has gradually become faithful to all 3 services and seems to be developing a very close, obedient walk with the Lord.

Jalyn was also baptized at Hope Baptist Church on March 10th. We met her through her children coming to our Summer Bible Camp which she heard about through the flyer we gave her. Jalyn grew up in the Philippines. She heard the gospel at a Bible club for kids in her neighborhood, but put it off. After surviving an earthquake, she realized that she shouldn't put it off and was saved. She was not baptized and moved to Italy. She was unable to find a gospel preaching church and struggled in her walk. Several years later, she moved to Ireland and has come back to the Lord with a heart to be committed and obedient. Her baptism is simply being an obedient believer.

About 3 years ago, **Julia** came to our church after receiving a flyer for our children's Summer Bible Camp. She had recently moved to Ireland with her Irish husband and two children. Julia grew up in Spain in a Catholic family that didn't attend church. Her older brother heard the gospel and got saved. The great change in his life made Julia curious. She found the gospel interesting, but didn't want to give up her sin. She heard the gospel several more times before visiting her sister in the US. Her sister & her sister's husband were saved and attending a Baptist church. They discussed the gospel on this visit. As she was leaving, they gave her a Bible. Reading the truth for herself in the Bible was what helped her to finally accept Christ as her Saviour. She was later baptized in Spain. On March 10, 2019, after giving her testimony, she became a member of Hope Baptist Church.
