The last week of January, after the Bible lesson at the juvenile center, two young men came to me wanting to know how to get to heaven. K. accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Savior while J. S. wasn't ready. I gave J. S. a tract and encouraged him to keep seeking God. The following week J. S. told me that he asked Jesus into his heart the very same night. I thank God for His mercies. Three weeks later P. also trusted in Christ followed by J. on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of March. I praise God for what He has done. These young people mostly have very difficult home situations and end up in juvenile centre for associating with the wrong crowd. While waiting for the change I accidentally dropped the pie to the ground. K. gave me another pie. I asked if he was sure he wanted to do that. His answer brought me into tears. He said, "Miss Coco, with all the Bible true you taught me I cannot even give you a little something for return." K. is now working and going to church faithfully!! God's Word changes lives!!

**God is so good to answer my prayers!** I had been praying for new opportunities to reach people with the Word of God. In March God opened a new door at the juvenile centre.
