Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

In my last update I asked for your prayers concerning finding a new place to live. Thank you for praying on my behalf, and God blessed me with a beautiful small house two weeks before the deadline.

**The psalmist says in Psalm 92:1, "It is a good thing to give thanks unto the Lord..." Therefore I thanked God when things went well.** To make the moving easier, I decided to do it in two days. God was so good to bless us with sunny days in this rainy season. Thursday June 20 was a school holiday. Two young men from church took down all the heavy shelves and set them up in my new house. They also installed the blinds and everything else that needed to drill holes in the wall. Both young men were skilful and hard working. I thanked God for them. Saturday some other men from church also came to help finish up the moving. They were so very kind to me. It was the third time in 19 months they helped me set up my house.

**I also thanked God when things went wrong.** On Saturday by ten o'clock in the evening I was getting ready for the night. The brand new electric shower heater exploded, shattered into many pieces and water was everywhere. It was a scary moment. *Praise the Lord I neither got hurt nor an electrical shock.* Then at three o'clock I woke up in the middle of the storm. When it slowed down, I heard a sound of running water. The water filter was leaking and flooded the house. I truly thanked God for waking me up. I thanked Him for allowing me to set up all the shelves on Thursday, and I was able to put all my books, flash cards, teaching materials and papers away before the flood.

**We Love Pastor Joe!** The children in my Sunday school class earn points by memorized Bible verses and bringing their Bible, notebook, and friends. They could use their points to buy toys or stationery from my cupboard. In April we had a pastor appreciation Sunday. We made a card and baked a cake for him. Some children used their points to buy Pastor a gift to show their thankfulness and love for him, and three children gave a meaningful speech. It touched my heart to see my kids are growing in different areas.



**Souls being saved is always the highlight in the ministry.** In the past three months I had been teaching the life of Christ and focusing on the crucifixion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The sacrifice Jesus made for us touched the heart of many of these young people. There were five students at the secondary school and ten young men at the juvenile centre who made professions of faith. Please pray for them to have the desire to live for the Lord, especially those in the juvenile centre to let God change their lives.
