At the end of March, we had a missions/construction team from Valley Forge Baptist Temple come down and help us construct our new home for the ministries of Community Baptist Church of Rocha. We started the work on Wednesday morning with unloading the material and beginning to put up the walls. By the end of the day Wednesday we had three walls and a part of the roof put up. It was great watching the faces of the neighbors as they were returning home from work; you could read their minds saying, "Where did that come from?" When they left in the morning there was a concrete slab and when they returned in the evening there was a mostly-finished building. By the end of Thursday, we had finished the roof and the last wall and had begun on the doors and windows. The building was constructed of isopanel, which is basically a 4 inch piece of styrofoam sandwiched between two pieces of metal sheeting. They came pre-cut and it was just a matter of connecting it all together. It was amazing how fast we were able to get everything done. We are so grateful for the group of men that came from Valley Forge. They were amazing!

That first Sunday, after the completion of the building, we were able to have our first service there. We didn't have power nor a bathroom, but we were able to meet, sing songs, give testimony and study the Word of God. We had a total of 37 in attendance, with the missions team and several neighborhood kids. It was a great first service!

While working, we have had several people from the neighborhood stop by and express interest in coming to the church. We are excited about what the future holds and how God will use this new tool.
