Dear pastor and families of the Church:

Receive a warm greeting from the city of Panama where the work of God goes on and the kingdom of God continues to spread. We love you in the Lord and we appreciate your prayers and all your help to us and this ministry.

I want to inform you that these months have been a blessing and a bit of nostalgia, because we have lost a sister of our church who was also my aunt, sister of my mother of only 55 years of age who lost the battle against the Lymphatic cancer in just one month. On Sunday, May 25, at 2 p.m in the afternoon, she went to heaven. She had a heart attack produced by the strong pains of the disease. In the funeral service that I officiated on the on a ranch close from the city owned by the family, more than thirty people accept the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal savior and more than two hundred listened the plan of salvation. She had received the Lord as her savior and had been baptized in our church four years ago. Thank God that since we arrived as missionaries in Panama that has been one of our goals, to reach the family for Christ.

We give thanks to God for the opportunity that our brothers Rigoberto Ballesteros and his wife Bellaniza had to continue one church that required a pastor in Penonomé Panama; two and a half hours from the city. Brother Rigoberto and his wife were saved, baptized and trained in our church to win souls and serve the Lord. They took classes in the institute and supported a missionary for a while but thank God they are now in charge of a work with a group of people to serve full time. They do not have economic support, we ask their prayers for them that God will provide them with the necessary things because they went and rented a small house to live and dedicate themselves to the work.

I would like to ask you to please pray for us that the Lord provides us; a house will be donated to my family but we had to pay the rest of the money from that house. The total payment to the bank is \$7,237 and be legally transferred to us. Because our support is very low we could not pay that amount even in seven years because everything that comes in is used for our maintenance and the needs of our children, school, food, expenses, etc. If you please help us by praying that the Lord will provide this amount, and if you can help us with a special offering for this project that is very important we would appreciate it. Thank you once again for your prayers and continue to support us in the mission field of Panama.

Thank you for transferring your help to the new missionary agency, we have received the report from them and we are very grateful for your missionary support. If you have not made the change yet you can do it sending your first help with a registration information form for the database of the agency that I enclose with this letter. Checks must be made out to the Central Missionary Clearinghouse (or CMC) and sent to this address, which is below this paragraph. Only the first shipment is with that form information, then you do not need to send a form.
