



Dear and appreciative Pastor, I wish you are doing well, we give you greetings and we share the missionary report and some photographs related to this month's letter. We thank you for your prayers and your financial support, which is a great blessing for the family and the work of God.

God's work continues, we continue to take the gospel from house to house and we are pleased every time we go out because, even if we do not find anyone, or someone does not want to attend us, or does not have the time; we can leave a bag of literature with the plan of salvation, an invitation to church, evangelistic pamphlets and a book of Romans that brings the plan of salvation. We also give a bag to the people who attend us. Some people have already visited us and have been saved as a result of this evangelistic effort. In these two months, people have received Christ and many more have heard the plan of salvation. We are also giving the studies to all those who are interested and have taken the step of being baptized as is the case of Brother Luis Gonzalez, Sister Raysa, Brother Ovidio, and others who have already concluded the discipleship lessons. We also thank God that Brother Armando and Sister Jesica decided to marry legally, this October.

In September we received the surprise of the visit of my in-laws Pastor Rafael Fiesco and Sister Alma. We were just waiting for my brother-in-law Moisés, (the children didn't know) but to everyone's surprise, my in-laws arrived with him. Their stay here was a great blessing for us, and I thank God that my wife and children were able to spend a great time with them. My daughter turned 16 on September 2 and they gave her a small celebration; we thank the Lord for that.

At this time the church is preparing for its missions conference during the national days of November. During these months, several missionaries visited us and our desire is also to support them as a church. We thank all those churches that support us, without ourselves being able to personally go to their churches -due to paper issues- we appreciate their consideration and support, and we pray that God prospers each one who participates in the missionary work.

On the other hand, the situation of the pandemic has diminished considerably in the country, the touch of cases has already been eliminated at the national level; there is already unrestricted mobility. For places of worship, they are demanding that to have a capacity of 100% (according to the decree). As a legal representative, you must first request it in writing to the regional office of the Ministry of Health. And all those interested in attending should have their complete vaccination schedule, their card, or their QR code; on the contrary, they are only authorized to 25%. Sports games are allowed 80% and bars and restaurants 50% but thanks to the Lord God guides and takes care of his church and we welcome everyone without any restriction, the Lord is close.

Once again we give thanks for your prayers and financial support, your contribution helps us to meet the many needs that we have each month in a world that is becoming more expensive every day. I ask for your prayers because we must already buy the study programs for our children and it is expensive, the program and the brought here of all its materials, each year we need approximately \$ 1,800 for their school education by video Stream as they have done for these years.
