We have been focusing for several months on a much needed **Christian Radio Station** in the pueblo of Tahdzibichen where Antonio is pastoring. We have been praying about a certain property there that would be ideal. Luis Balam, Pastor Antonio, Efrain, and Santos have been working there cleaning it up recently. The best news is that it appears that the village will GIVE it to us for a radio station. Praise the Lord! Please pray about this! Imagine how much a Christian radio station could do to reach more of the people there. Our programming would be in three different languages: Spanish, English, and Mayan. That would help us reach three groups: the majority of the people who speak Spanish, the school children who must have at least one year of English, and the older generation who may speak some Spanish, but mainly speak Mayan.

The programming could include: weather, news, presenting the gospel, Christian music, Biblical teaching about God, man, creation vs. evolution, and the family. The possibilities are endless!
