### After Quarantine

Here in Moldova, everything was pretty much shut down and people were asked to remain at home for almost 2 full months in order to slow down the spread of Covid-19. During our 2 months of quarantine, Daniel sent out audio messages both Sunday and Wednesday to almost all of our members. There are still a few of the older generation who do not use the internet or social media, so instead of audio messages, Daniel spent time calling each of those members. Social media allowed us to stay in contact with everyone, but it is just never the same as physically being together as a church. After 2 months of not being allowed to meet as a church, we were finally allowed to meet outside at the church as long as we also followed many strict guidelines. After two weeks of meeting outside, we were allowed to meet inside our building, but again, still using masks and social distancing as required. Here in Hincesti over the course of 2 months, there have been only 18 cases of Covid-19, and praise the Lord, none of our church members have been affected or even sick during this time. Beginning this week, we are also starting back to all of our regular Bible studies which are with our men, our women, and then Wednesdays altogether. **We have many that are excited about studying God's Word together, but please pray especially for those who already were inconsistent before this 2 month pause.**
