This is a Praise and Prayer Report! My first week back in PNG Pastor Robert Sperbeck, Bro Daniel Ramirez and I ministered in the capitol as well as in Kiunga and Ningerum. It started out with nightly meetings at Bible Believers Baptist Church in the capitol city. Then we flew to Kiunga for 3 nights of meetings at Kiunga Independent Baptist Church. I am so thankful to report that many visitors came in both places and in Kiunga we saw 4 folks call on Christ for salvation!

We also had the privilege of visiting and preaching in a number of villages along the highway leading out of Kiunga as well. Will you pray for souls to be receptive as we have sown the seed in these needy areas? We especially request prayer for the town of Ningerum. The fellowship there now has about 15 faithful folks. Recently the local level government officers allocated a piece of property within the state-owned land for us to build a permanent church building on. This is a huge answer to prayer! Please continue to pray that the Lord will provide the funds and the people needed to help this church plant

Our plans to build our first house in PNG are moving forward. I have met with a local Christian contractor about the details. We still plan to use a light gauge steel frame because of the difficulty we have experienced with the termites in the area. I have also secured the advice of the town's building inspector, who is also an architect. Please pray for wisdom as we move forward with these plans.

Our search for the appropriate vehicle is still ongoing. With the remote location that we are in all of the vehicles have to be shipped up the river which is approximately 700 nautical miles just from the mouth of the river to our river port. This obviously cuts down on the amount of used vehicles available and also adds to the price of everything. Please pray for wisdom and patience for us as we search.

Overall, my 36 days in PNG on this last trip were fruitful, enlightening and very busy! I thank God for the souls saved, the ministry work that was accomplished, for giving me good health during the trip and for taking care of my family in my absence. Now that I am back in US I will be having my gallbladder removed on November 19th. Please pray that there are no complications and that we can be ready to return to PNG on December 3rd. We already have our plane tickets purchased and all the necessary visa paperwork approved. We are excited about getting back into the work!
