From ice storms to sunny days to blizzards to rain, from full churches to "virtual" meetings, it has not been "the usual." We are excited to remind you all that Lord-willing, this will be our last prayer letter sent from here in the states! We will continue our travels over the month of April and into the first part of May. We will be flying home to Brazil on May 14th. Please pray for the remainder of our travels and for no cancellations on flights.

We are excited to have been in some new churches, as well as reporting to many that have supported us over the last few years. We are thankful that the Lord has already added two more churches to help support us. We will continue traveling over the next few weeks along the East Coast, with meetings scheduled in PA, MD, VA, and WV.

We were able to register Gabriel and purchase his schoolbooks in preparation for starting his Kindergarten year when we return to the field. He and Adelyn have thoroughly enjoyed all the Sunday school and Wednesday night programs as we have visited our supporting churches. Caleb has finally started going to nurseries without crying and clinging to Shaney. We are thankful for all of the patient nursery workers that have helped him adapt to this part of American culture.

It is hard for us to believe that in less than two months, we will be back home. We are excited to return, even with many Covid restrictions still in place. We ask that you pray for the Colombian land borders to reopen, which would allow the annual medical trip to take place in July.

Thank you all for the continued love, support, and encouragement that we have received throughout our first term and first furlough! It truly is an honor to be your partner in the Great Commission in the Amazon region. Until the next adventure!
