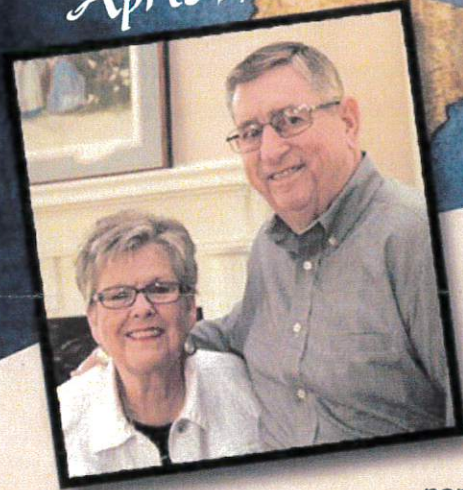


Reaching:
