A group from Newton Baptist Church in Covington, GA came and ministered with us. Ethan Howeth, the youth pastor lead their group and they all did a great job serving In a variety of ways.



For our VBS we distributed out over 5000 flyers, most of which went directly into the public schools. Our people joined in prayer together to saturate these special days with God's blessings. Many of our people gave special offerings to help with the extra costs. But something that really stuck out this year was the amount of volunteers we had working during the week. It was a lot of work but in reality I believe those that served were truly blessed by what they saw and experienced throughout the week.



Kids are super special! "Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven." (Mat 19:14). The great evangelist D.L. Moody said "If I could relive my life, I would devote my entire ministry to reaching children." After being a part of an entire week, morning and evening, devoted to ministering to children and teens I would definitely say "amen" to those words.



Each of the four days the children heard a lesson from their teacher, a message from a preacher, and "The Four Fact" tract by another preacher. We did our best to saturate their hearts with the gospel. By the end of the week 26 kids had made professions of faith!!! We had over 70 children in attendance by the end of the week.
