Dear Friends and Family,

Wow! It seems surreal to be back in South Africa. One minute we are sleeping in our bed in Tunnel Hill, GA and the next we are **8,652 miles away** sleeping in our bed in Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth) South Africa! God is so GOOD!

We had a bit of a setback on our way back as our covid tests did not meet the strict criteria for travel through Germany. Therefore, we had to reschedule for a flight two days later. But all in all, we had a great trip back and were met with an incredibly warm welcome at the airport by friends, family and a singing group from Madiba Bay Baptist Church (Pastor Lubabalo Sitele).

We have settled on a location for the building of Bay Baptist Training Centre (Bible College). There is still a bit of debate on what we will actually name it 😊. The lighthearted struggle is between the terms "training center" and "college." Otherwise, we have met with the builder and he has given us his price for building the first building which we are calling "**The Victory Building.**" He has quoted us a price of \$8500 for his labor. The building will be approximately 29 feet by 36 feet in size with a high ceiling of 14ft in the front shed off to the back. It will serve multiple purposes. It will be used for classrooms, chapel, and possibly other things such as meetings for mission groups, and various other special meetings. We are so thankful for the church that gave a huge offering to hopefully fully complete this building! They know who they are in Arkansas! We hope to train many young men and women for ministry within these future walls. Pictures will come as we progress. We are aiming to have the building ready for classes in August!!!

The churches are doing well but the men God has raised up are doing even better. I am very proud of how they have been faithful and grown during our absence. Pastor Stefan has become a solid preacher of the word. You can listen to his messages on the Grace Baptist Church youtube page if you would like. Damien has also been very faithful, continuing to disciple young men and lead in the church plant in Kuyga. **He is baptizing a promising young man named Sisipho this coming Sunday!**

Youth meetings are up and running and our numbers have grown over the past few weeks from around 12 the first week, then 27, to **33 this past Friday night.** Every week we have a solid Bible message from one of the pastors and a shorter message from one of the youth preachers. We follow this up with scripture memory time, a snack, and some game time. Pray God would touch some men and women's hearts amongst these teens to go into full-time Christian service. I personally am asking God to give us 30 students for the Bible College!



As soon as I got back Pastor Lubabalo asked me to come preach in Xhosa at a prayer meeting for one of the two funerals he was busy doing that week. I was able to preach to a room full of people, many members of the family that were lost. Pray God would use that message to save someone!

#### A few prayer requests to leave with you:

1. Finish the Victory Building before classes start in August.
2. Find a building for Grace Baptist Church - Also for the funds to purchase it. We have one supporting church that has shown great interest in helping with this. We are busy searching!
3. Another new church to be planted soon.
4. For Kuyga Baptist Church as we kickstart a more rigorous outreach program
