We are in the process of installing a new six roll printing press in our BPS shop at Milford. This facility will have the capacity to print one million whole Bibles annually. Others have paid for the press. Will you help pay for paper?

As you know, we have been working in Mongolia for 17 years with the ministry of the Cophers. Over the years we have seen a church planted, two print shops established and a translation office that employs four full-time translators. We have translated and have in print the New Testament. We are in the process of completing the Old Testament. The Lord willing, we will complete the whole Bible and have it press ready by 2023.


We believe it takes two things to evangelize a nation:

**One**, the Word of God in the receptor nation and mother tongue and,  
**Two**, train nationals to do the work of the ministry.

The missing link in our Mongolia ministry was our ability to train nationals. The good news is there is now a bona fide college, Mongolian Bible College, that we can partner with in ministry.
