Dear Pastors and Friends,

May and June 2019

Greetings once again! We are so excited to share with you what God has been doing these past couple of months here in Cambodia! Thank you all for your continual support and prayer for us! We'd like to thank you also for all of the birthday wishes!

It was a blessing in May to visit several of our supporting churches while I was on a short furlough with my two daughters. We are grateful to Harvest Baptist Church, Grace Baptist Church, Valley Chinese Baptist Church, First Baptist Church, Victory Baptist Church, Bible Baptist Church, Gospel Light Baptist Church, West Coast Baptist Church, and Canyon Ridge Baptist Church for giving us the privilege to update them on the work in Cambodia.

*Construction on our new church property has continued to make progress! Recently, we were able to pour the slab for the ground floor and the pillars were able to be put up! We are thankful to God for allowing us to continue work on this endeavor. In a few weeks, in each of our four ministry locations, we will have an offering to buy bricks. We want to thank the churches who have already given towards the purchase of the land and the construction of the church building. **Please pray that God will provide for our needs and that we will be able to quickly complete this project.***

*We are thankful for our U. S. Men Ministry. Every Saturday, we play basketball with them for a couple of hours. There have been about 20 of them who have been coming faithfully. Please pray for these people we are currently working with: Jake, Srey Leak, Kosal, Vuthy, and Sal. Please pray that God will open their hearts to the gospel as we try to build relationships with them. Also, the U. S. government has just recently deported about 38 more men back to Cambodia. Most of these men grew up in America and don't know much about the Cambodian culture and it will take them some time to get adjusted. **Please pray that God will open the door for us to reach out to these men with the gospel.***

*Our oldest son, Justin, has the opportunity to serve in various ministries here in our church. We are thankful for this opportunity for him to grow and bear fruit. Recently, he has helped lead two boys to the Lord, Chea and Rotha. These two boys are a part of the children's ministry in Ondong village. Most of the children in this village are already saved, but there are a few who are not. **Please pray for growth for the ones who have professed faith in Christ and salvation for those who have not.***

Lastly, I want to ask for prayer for some of the older folks in our Romdeng ministry. We have about six who come every Friday and Sunday. All of these people are in their 70's and 80's: Thahn, Ros, Yahm, and Ouk. There are two more older folks who come, but we do not have a picture of them.
