Progress is currently being made on our new church property! We are thankful to God for allowing the construction to move along quickly. Thank you to all of you who have given towards this project! It is a huge blessing and help to our ministry! There are many things that need to be paid for and bought and below is a list of items and their estimated expenses that our ministry needs: *Walkway rail: \$2,800, Extra slab project: \$1000, balcony stairs: \$495, Auditorium doors: \$1701, windows: \$2,850, exterior paint: \$3,100, auditorium tiles: \$3,780, ground floor tiles: \$3,840, interior paint: \$4,300, electric supplies: \$5,000, brick labor: \$6,000, generator: \$13,500.* Please pray that progress will continue, and that God will provide for us as there is still much funds and work needed.
