We bring greetings to you from Myanmar! We trust that you have had a wonderful time of celebrating the birth of our Savior. Christmas had never been celebrated before as it has been over the past two years. This year is no exception. Huge Christmas trees and Christmas music are commonplace in all the shopping malls, and downtown streets are beautifully decorated. Even the second Vice President of the country hosted a Christmas party at his place, where the Lady (Mrs. Suu Kyi) gave a Christmas speech! The good Lord has blessed our family and ministries in a variety of ways during the year 2019, and I would like to give you a summary of the year's activities.

Church Planting

Church planting has always been the primary focus of our ministry. The year 2019 was a year of strengthening the four missionaries we have sent out to plant Bible-believing churches. We visited them and helped them with church building projects. All four of them now have a place to stay and of worship. Moreover, the Lord has blessed them with an increased membership in their churches. Praise the Lord.

Training Nationals

We graduated a total of 15 men and women in February of 2019. We praise the Lord for sending Dr. Dave Smith of Open Door Baptist Mission to be the keynote speaker and Dr. Brent Armstrong of Tucson Baptist Church, Tucson, Arizona to give the charge to the graduates. Most of these graduates are in the ministry now. A couple of them will pursue further studies.

In order to provide better environment and facilities to the future leaders of the country, the Lord has enabled us to begin a school building project in February. He has enabled us to complete a lot in a year, and we give all the glory to God and to all those who have prayed for and supported the project. In June, we enrolled 68 students, which include the returning students.

During the month of October, I was privileged to teach at a pastors' seminar up in the Chin state for three days.

What a joy it was to see the pastors receiving the Word with joy and excitement.

Furlough

We praise the Lord for enabling us to visit half of our supporting churches in America during the months of April, May and June. What a joy and blessing it was to be able to see and fellowship with godly men and women who have been praying for us and supporting us.

Camps and Evangelism

While we were on furlough, two gospel teams, from the students, conducted camps in two places, resulting in the salvation of several people. In one camp, ten people got saved, whereas, in the other camp about 30 people got saved. As usual, our church held a camp right our church and a few people got saved as well. The youth group from our church conducted a camp at Labuatta and 30 teenagers received Christ as their Lord and Savior; most of them received water baptism during Christmas!

Christmas has always been one of the best times to share the Gospel. We visited two of our church planters to conduct Christmas celebration. We were able to present the message of Christmas and distributed some presents. We did not see immediate salvation decisions, but we are so glad that the seed has been sown in the hearts of those heathens.

Family Seminar

Dr. Bob was so gracious to be the keynote speaker at the family seminar at our church. All his lectures and sermons were a tremendous blessing to the students and members of our church. The Lord used him to transform some of our church folks who have been going through family struggles.
