One of our goals for this furlough visit is to continue raising funds for our school building project. When we came to America three years ago, we were at 10%. Over the past three years, the Lord has marvelously added several percentages to the project, and we are at 70% now! Praise the Lord! Please continue to pray that the Lord will provide the remaining 30%.

The Lord has answered our prayers concerning the building permits. We held the groundbreaking ceremony on January 18 and work has begun since. We are so thankful to the Lord for letting us cross our path with a Christian contractor, who has been rendering

his best service to the project with care and concern. As of now, we have water and electricity; the concrete slab for the first floor of the girls' dorm was poured just two days ago on April 1; the laying of the foundation for the main building has already begun; and the fence is almost done.

The Bible school was founded on the first of August 1995. Next year is our silver jubilee. It is our prayer that the Lord would allow us to celebrate His goodness over the past twenty-five years, along with holding a building dedication service. Would you please pray with us to this end?
