Church members put a praise video clip virtually, and reached out to our fellow brothers and sisters through call- giving encouragement and prayers as we struggle amid the pandemic.

The singles gathered at a big park nearby our Church, and fellowshiped as we kept our social distance by talking on a group call while walking individually.
