Dear Ministry Partners and Prayer Warriors,

We apologize for the lateness of this update. This letter is tardy in part due to a great "Family Week" we attended at the AFBM headquarters in Chesapeake, Virginia. We received targeted training in 9 areas that are important in creating and maintaining relationships with churches and other areas of ministry. While in Michigan and Virginia, we visited 3 supporting churches. After we arrived home, one emergency and some other urgent things arose that needed our immediate attention. It has been a turbulent week, and we are exhausted, but the Lord is good and has faithfully helped us every step of the way.

The end of July ushered in a short vacation to see family in Michigan. **Dan's mom** has been in and out of the ER in recent weeks. We had the privilege of visiting with her a few times, and had concerns about her profession of faith from 5 years ago. While there, we gave her the gospel message again. **She sincerely prayed and received Christ!!** 

Both Dan and Kelly have been given more responsibility in the local military chapel, and we hope that Dan will soon be able to lead a Bible study there. Kelly plans to attend a morning ladies Bible study at chapel that will be starting shortly. As we move forward in ministry, the enemy continues to seek to devour,

destroy and hinder. Please pray for open doors, and please be in prayer for the spiritual and physical health of us and our children. We've suffered physical and spiritual attacks within our family. In fact, a few weeks ago we asked special prayer on our ministry Facebook account for our son Jordan, who was under serious spiritual attack. He is doing a little better because people are praying for him, not because the issue is resolved. Please pray the Lord will help him settle this issue.



In other news, **Dan has temporarily become bi-vocational once again**. Our church's Christian school has a large enrollment this year, but they were down by 5 teachers. Dan's name was floated, and Pastor Hon asked him to pray about working there this school year. We prayed, and Dan believed the Lord would have him work at GCS for one school year, as a **proctor** for some classes, and as a teacher for music theory. This will be a help to our school, but will also **help us financially as some big expenditures have come up in the past year**. For example: **our HVAC died, our refrigerator died, and then the front brakes on the car needed resurfacing**. Praise God, this extra income will help to pay back the debts we have incurred!

As always, we are so thankful for your prayers for us, for our military, and for your financial support to our ministry. Know that we are praying for you as well. May God richly bless you as we seek spiritual fruit in our ministry that may abound to your account.
