The month of October brought us to Southland Christian Camp in Ringgold, Louisiana. There we received 12 hours of intense training. We both gained much insight, and under the authority of our local church, look forward to using this training in the coming year.

Now that the Lord has allowed us to raise 100% of our support, our home church invited us to re-present our ministry, as part of their Veteran's Day services. At the end of the service we came forward and the **church laid hands on us and prayed for God's blessing** on His future ministry to our military heroes at Fort Benning. They specifically prayed for the Lord to open doors of ministry for us, and praise the Lord, on November 15 **Dan had a meeting with the chaplain that was considering having us help him** with a Bible study ministry to his soldiers! **He approved the idea** of allowing us to minister to the Infantry Basic Training soldiers in his unit! Step one accomplished! On November 26 this same chaplain sent our information to the Religious Affairs Office to start the process. Dan was informed, on December 1, that his request must first be approved by the incoming Deputy Post Chaplain before the Religious Affairs office can initiate the background check and the volunteer processing paperwork. Dan has sent character references to the Religious Affairs officer and to the unit chaplain. Yes, there is **much red tape to get through** to make this happen. We wait expectantly for the Lord's blessing in this area. **Please pray** for our Lord to work mightily throughout all of the required steps. (Prov. 21:1; Mat. 21:21-22) We will continue to keep you informed as to the progression of this process via Facebook or (upon request) via email or text. **Please also pray** for us to have wisdom in this process. We don't want to push too hard, but we don't wish to be forgotten, either.

<u>Please pray</u> for **Kelly's dad**. He is in great need of **heart valve replacement surgery** as soon as possible. There are some hurdles here as well.
