Late last year, there was a chaplain that was interested in allowing us to teach his soldiers, but he has since changed his mind. This was discouraging, but our God always has a plan for our lives. The Lord has given us a **tremendous helper in 1SG Shomaker**. God used this wonderful Christian man to pave the way for us to meet a **chaplain who is interested in having us come minister to his troops!** Last Thursday I met this chaplain in person and attended his evening Bible study. Afterward, he said he’d like me to lead studies that focus on the gospel of Christ and on discipleship as well! We have another **meeting with him on Thursday, February 6**. **Please pray for perfect communication between us, and for plain path leadership from the Lord.**

We have not heard from the **Religious Affairs office** on post as of yet. I will be in constant communication with our interested chaplain in hopes that he can get that office to initiate and complete our **background checks**. We are trusting God to move hearts in getting our **packet** completed which could get Kelly and I permanently approved for ministry service on Fort Benning. **Please pray for our Lord to work mightily throughout all of the required steps.**

This Tuesday I will be working out details with my pastor, as he has **agreed to allow us the use of one building** to form a support group for those who suffer with PTSD (**Post Traumatic Stress Disorder**). Kelly and I have received training in Bible-based PTSD counseling from our mission board. Our goal for this class will be to help attendees receive healing from the Great Physician Who loves them and knows all that they are, and have been, going through. The gospel will also be shared as new people come. **Please pray for these classes to start up soon and for salvations and healings for those who attend.**

Thank you for your prayers for Kelly’s dad, and for our son, Jordan, with their recent health concerns. They are doing so much better! **Please continue to pray for more opportunities to minister on base.** Also, **please pray** for the Lord’s **continued blessing and hedge of protection** upon us, and upon our family. We are always thankful for the prayer support and financial support that you faithfully give on our behalf. Know that we are praying for you as well! To God be all the glory!!
