Dear Ministry Partners,

As with all other ministries in the world, **COVID-19 social distancing** demands have **caused most of our ministries to be temporarily suspended**. As some of you have seen on our Facebook page, a local news station announced that over 140 Soldiers in Basic Training at Ft. Benning have recently tested positive for the COVID-19 virus, including 2 Drill Instructors. We ask for your prayers for the swift recovery of these Soldiers, and that the Lord will halt the spread of this virus on post. Also, please continue to pray for possible reopening of ministries in the weeks ahead.

Since our last prayer letter, **Dan has completed his College Algebra** class with a final grade of “B” (this is an answer to prayer from our last prayer letter!). Amen! He is **currently taking a Systematic Theology** class. Dan has also been working on **simplifying a tract** he wrote a few years ago. We had noticed, in our previous military Bible studies, that many of our troops don’t speak English as their first language. At the same time others speak English well but have not been brought up in a church using terminology that has become familiar to us. Our hope is for this new tract to meet that need, and to help bring more souls to Christ!

On April 10, **Kelly broke a fingertip** when a door slammed on the ring finger of her left hand on a windy day. We had to go to an urgent care station to get the ring cut off her finger, which had swollen up right away. We both wore masks but were shocked to find that *none* of the staff there were wearing masks! As a result, we **self-isolated for 2 weeks**. Thankfully, even though Kelly ran a temperature for 4 days, neither of us became sick with the pandemic virus. Praise the Lord! Since then her finger has been healing fairly well. Kelly has been working on our garden and counseling some ladies online. We rejoice in all these things, and also praise the Lord that Jordan, our youngest son, is doing well and has returned to work!



Thank you again for your prayers and financial support! Know that we pray for all of you as well! May you all stay safe, stay healthy, and continue to grow in mercy and grace.
