House of Prayer Baptist Church: Our church continues to move through the Bible's "Big Story" in our Sunday School classes. We have three groups (children, teens, and adults) that are all studying the same material. As we mentioned previously, we began this study in January with Genesis 1:1, and we only recently finished the book of Genesis. The "Book of Beginnings" has provided an incredible foundation for our people! Last Sunday, our church celebrated its third anniversary! We are so thankful to reach this milestone, and we are praying for God's continued blessing!

Pastor's School: The Pastor's School continues to move forward, and the men involved are growing significantly. One of the core values of our Pastor's School is that we desire to give the men significant opportunities in ministry during their studies. This is because we desire to start new village churches as soon as these men are prepared. Three of the men involved are moving into these ministry opportunities. Luis is teaching weekly and preaching occasionally. David (a newer student) is now teaching once per month and leading worship for our midweek service. Bryan is heavily involved in evangelism.

Problems in the Village: Recently, two families in the village where the church is located had a very significant disagreement. Laura and I have had the opportunity to sit down with both parties to discuss the situation. While the facts remain unclear, we know that God is aware of all that is happening and it is clear that He is working. The parents of the two families involved do not attend our church, but all of their children are very faithful to the services. The good news is that both families have reached out to us for help. It is yet another open door to pour truth into these families' lives as we share God's Word with

them. Please pray for the salvation of the families involved, for Godly wisdom for Laura and myself, and that this situation would not cause a division between the children in our church.

Making Disciples!: A young couple came to our home about 6 months ago because they were experiencing marital problems. After talking with them for a couple of hours, we realized that the wife (Gladys) did not know Christ as her Savior. We turned the conversation to the Gospel. Gladys admitted that she had never been saved, and we praise God that in our home that night, she received Christ! She has shown an incredible desire to grow spiritually! Laura is discipling Gladys, and they meet weekly to study. Please pray for Gladys and for her husband, Freddy.

Vivi Finally Made it to Argentina!: As many of you may remember, Vivi is a young lady that received Christ one year at teen camp where I had the privilege to preach. She was baptized, and then she helped us as an intern for two years in the new church plant. She played a vital role in the ministry, specifically in helping us with the teens.
