Update on the Virus Situation: Things are slowly returning to normal here in Ecuador. In fact, many of the restrictions in our area have been lifted, and people are expected to take care of their own health. Thankfully, the people in our ministry that were infected with the virus have all recuperated without any serious complications.

House of Prayer Baptist Church: After completing a systematic study of the Bible's unfolding narrative, we began teaching the believers about the Christian life. We have been studying different doctrines about Salvation, the work of the Holy Spirit, and the importance of the Bible and the local church in the life of a believer.
