In addition to the challenges of teaching, we also need to improve our fire safety and first aid kit in the pre-school. Momma and I attended a government sponsored conference this summer which encouraged the private schools to bring their health and fire safety up to code. We were provided with some guidelines and need to install some smoke detectors, a fire extinguisher, and a more complete first aid kit. Since we are a small facility this will not be difficult, but it will cost about \$400US. Our prayer is that we will be able to take care of this need quickly.
