

Cindy and I are awaiting availability of flights to China. There are some that are available but highly overpriced (\$5,000 each or more for a one-way airfare). In June we are seeing some prices that are still outrageous but attainable.

The other issue is that upon arrival you must be quarantined in their facility for three weeks. This would add to the cost of the trip (\$50 a night) that doesn't include meals.

I think after a few more months, issues there will resolve, and hopefully international travel will return to normalcy.

In recent years our support level has dropped due to economic struggles here in America, and due to frequent changes in our supporting church's mission policies. To compound problems the cost of living in China has risen drastically and exchange rates are not favorable. All missionaries face this at one time or another and it is our time to deal with this. So, Cindy and I are traveling on weekends to meet with new/old churches to give an update or introduce our ministry. If you desire to have us come to your church, please call us at: 205-789-6922.

Our eight churches in China are doing well. They have the exact same struggles there that our churches have here. Some church members have grown ac-customed to staying home instead of going to church. Some have severe fears, but others have great faith and realize the need for church and continue to go each Sunday.

Each year, in March, new policies arise concerning every aspect of life for the Chinese. Please pray that any new policies will not affect the churches in China. There is a big push in China for all house churches to be registered and for all unregistered pastors to register with the government. Once registered then the government consume your time with meetings that attempt to indoctrinate the pastors.
