He's our pastor on the Eastern point of Hainan Island in Wenchang. He is fluent in the National language of China (Mandarin) but also speaks the local Language, Hainan Hua and its different dialects. Also, his English is exceptional, and he is part of our translation team. To give you an idea of his linguistic abilities, he decided to learn Japanese on his own and now his fluency is to the level he can preach from a Japanese Bible while still preaching in his native tongue of Hainan Hua.

At his location, the government is not as restrictive but pro-active to have him involved in the churches in rural areas of his county. Brian reputation for language is well known among the government officials. They all respect his education so they will actually send him to the government churches to teach the rural pastors. Most of the rural pastors have little or no education so the officials worry about what they will teach so Brian has been given the open door to minister to them. God has been good to Brian and his family since most of China is under different levels of persecution.

Health Update: At the end of August, I will be ten months post-op from heart surgery.

I'm not 100% but doctors are pleased at my progress. The COVID-19 situation still has us grounded here and prevents international travel.
