As you know we were trapped and could not get back because of COVID, our tickets were canceled four times, but they are booked and we fly back to Chile in November. We know that things are still very difficult on the field, but trust our Lord that the hearts of the people are more ready to hear and receive Gods Word. I have been preaching online every week to the Church in Santiago, so the people are faithful and ready to return to regular services when the country is finally opened up again.

This week is the one-year anniversary since all the problems with the riots that started last year and even now things are not good in Chile. This month they are voting to change the constitution and the protesting and rioting is starting back again. This past Sunday they burned down two catholic churches that were used by the police for ceremonies.





Please pray we can pay off the car we used on our furlough and the expense of our reentry to Chile. The airline raised the price of our tickets, because there are so few airlines flying in and are making us do a 14-day mandatory quarantine. Also, pray for Armando that I met out visiting, he came to church the next day and received Christ. We are ready to continue preaching the gospel in Chile and seeing many souls come to Christ. Thank you for your faithfulness and heart for missions!
