Grenada is still shut down to international visitors. American Airlines called and “officially” cancelled our trip this summer, but not only ours, but the 100 plus people who were coming in as well. Many are interested in rolling over their plans to now take place in July 2021.

The schools in Grenada are scheduled to reopen in September this fall. St. George’s University isn’t scheduled to reopen until early 2021 because of the number of international students. The government offices have now reopened. The paperwork and fees for the permits for the new church building for Pastor Thomas have been submitted. We pray the construction of the church building will begin before the end of August! The money needed for the new church building has all been raised and we truly thank God for that! This will be the third church building in nineteen and half years the Lord has allowed us to have a part in building and we are so excited!

Our schedule is full for the next 6 months and we are excited about that, too! We appreciate your prayers as we start to travel again, speaking in churches, sharing the Grenada ministry. We are praying these meetings will be able to take place as planned.

We thank God for each of you! Your prayers and financial support keep us going and none of the above could have happened without you! We are forever grateful!
