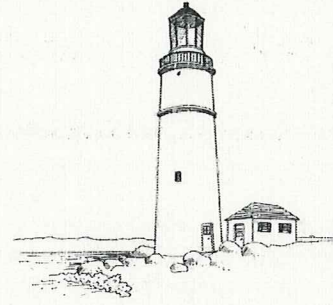


# Quinlan's to Guam
