I could tell the man was troubled so I started to witness to him through the crack around the door. The man received the Word of God and soon trusted Christ as His Saviour. I began to give him some follow up material when out of the darkness came another voice, "Hey, give me some of that also. I got saved, too!" Unbeknownst to me, there were two men in that cell and, even in the darkness, men were saved that day. What a blessing!
