Since arriving home from Florida, the weather has been quite mild for Pickle Lake until the past few days. For many days, we were walking outside in just a sweatshirt or light jacket. But this is the NORTH!!! We awoke to temperatures in the -30sF, creating wind chills of almost -50F. A warm home and burning woodstoves are on the top of my list of blessings right now!



Our Safe Zone group has been going well. We have a few boys now attending. We had a record of 11 kids last week. We changed our Bible time format to include more continuity. Please pray for these kids to see God’s love for them and their need of a Saviour. Our desire is to transition them to attend the new youth group program and then eventually to attend Church.

Our January trip up north was postponed due to an unexpected broken molar. For a little prospective: The closest dentist is 3 hours south. When needed, you call one of the offices and tell them your dilemma and see whom has time to fix the problem. Most likely, you will have to wait at least 24 hrs or more for an appointment.
