preaching and got to fly out to a Pastor's conference in Lae recently. Sarah Glover is managing the clinic well, along with organizing the team of short-term missionaries and other tasks. Laura-Lee continues to do a good job in teaching literacy and helping in other areas. Chelsea, Danya, Kyle, and Lauren stay busy with the clinic and in some of the church ministries. We have also heard good reports about some of the nationals who have been stepping up in the ministry and serving the Lord. John and Lena Allen have moved to Port Moresby due to Lena's health, and they continue to be a vital part of our team in Bible translation, organizing and supplying the medical supplies for the clinic, and getting supplies for the missionaries in the bush. Bro. Allen has had ministry opportunities since their move and also taught at the pastors' meeting in Lae.
