Partner with PCOM committees and members in this process. Develop World Communion Sunday Event, October 4, 2020. Drive in Communion, elements served to members in cars, pastors share a message. Build upon online ministry, elevate and improve technology upgrades. Be mindful of staff and workloads required for these options, strive to maintain balance.
