Covid 19 Preparedness Plan

1. We will reduce our sanctuary seating for in-person worship services. We will open at 25% of our capacity. We will do this by removing every other row in the Sanctuary and moving it downstairs to our large room beneath the Sanctuary.
2. If we reach capacity in our main sanctuary, with fewer pews and safe distancing in place, we will have an overflow room downstairs that will have a live video feed that people can watch.
3. We will consider having additional services during the day, on the weekend or during the week, if needed. Sufficient time between each service, if needed, will be given to allow for proper sanitization.
4. If we reach maximum attendance for the reduced seating, the remaining people can participate in worship via a parking lot service via the use of our FM transmitter we have used for Drive In Church.
5. If possible, we will simulcast the worship service online via various platforms (Facebook, YouTube)

6. The MN Governor is asking for voluntary compliance with a new statewide mask mandate. We realize that many people cannot wear masks for extended periods due to a variety of **wellness** reasons. As such, we encourage each person to decide what is best for their situation. We have disposable masks available for anyone who may need one.

Reopening Plan - Health & Safety Measures

1. Any person who has had any contact with known COVID-19 confirmed cases or who has flu symptoms or fever will be instructed to stay home and self-quarantine.
2. High-risk individuals based on age or predisposed health conditions will be advised not to attend the in-person service.
3. Prior to and following any in-person service, the facility will be sanitized.
4. Attendees will be advised that, if they choose, they may wear masks and/or gloves.
5. Hand sanitizer will be available for use throughout the facility.
6. Doors will be propped open or held open by greeters to prevent the need for congregants to touch doors while entering and exiting the church or sanctuary.
7. The measures the church takes will be communicated to church members in advance.
8. We will utilize trash cans that do not require manually opening a door or lid.
9. We will urge people to thoroughly wash their hands and post appropriate signage in restrooms.
10. We will disable drinking fountains and place signs nearby that the fountains are not in service.
11. Regarding communion, we will use pre-packaged containers set out on tables.
12. Regarding offerings, we will have a collection receptacle where people can deposit contributions without touching the container, as well as continue to encourage online donation giving.
13. Regarding small children, families will be expected to keep their children with them during the service as we will not be hosting a nursery nor any children's church activities for the time being.
14. We will provide a webpage that provides notice and guidance of the procedures and processes and will communicate the information via social media and email.
