

REOPENING GUIDELINES FOR BIBLE STUDY (SUNDAY SCHOOL):

EVERYONE

- Masks are optional while congregating in hallways, foyer, outside the doors, etc.
- We will work to educate and train all volunteers regarding the guidelines.
- We will ask anyone who feels sick to stay home.
- We will lean on a team of medically trained individuals to help guide us beyond these steps.
- Hand sanitizer stations, gloves, and masks will be available at all main entrances and ministry areas.

PRESCHOOL

- It is recommended that one parent drop off their children to cut down on traffic.
- Upon arrival into the nursery, a worker (wearing gloves) will check you into touchpoint.
- A worker will administer a touchless forehead temperature check to the children being checked in.
- Consider the hallways as traffic lanes. Staying to the right side of the hallway while moving forward is good while crossing lanes to the left side of the hallway could be problematic.
- Workers will be screened and briefed prior to services to confirm readiness and hygiene to serve.
- Rooming arrangements will accommodate social distancing and intentionally combat clustering.

CHILDREN

- It is recommended that one parent drop off their children to cut down on traffic.
- Upon arrival into the Children's area, a worker (wearing gloves) will check you into touchpoint.
- Consider the hallways as traffic lanes. Staying to the right side of the hallway while moving forward is good while crossing lanes to the left side of the hallway could be problematic.
- Workers will be screened and briefed prior to services to confirm readiness and hygiene to serve.
- Rooming arrangements will accommodate social distancing and intentionally combat clustering.

STUDENTS/ADULTS

- Rooms will be cleaned and sanitized prior to Bible Study (Sunday School).
- COVID response for Bible Study (SS) will be as follows:
If someone in the Bible Study group **tests positive** for COVID, we ask that they contact their Bible Study leader and Bro. Dyer immediately so that everyone in the Bible Study group can be made aware and self-quarantine. The Bible Study group may be dismissed as a precaution for two weeks at which time we will look at safely reopening it.
We will protect the identity of the individual(s) that tested positive for COVID and it will be up to them to disclose their identity to avoid embarrassment, gossip and panic.
