LETTER FROM YOUR PASTOR

"DEEPER...DEVOTED"

THC Members, God did something quite remarkable in our hearts this year. At the beginning of this year my New Year's verse was Galatians 6:9 - *"And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up."* This year, from my perspective, seemed to be filled with reminders of that verse coming into fruition.

Every year that I've been your Pastor I try to gather a sense of where the Holy Spirit is leading THC in the coming year. In 2017, it was **"Family on Mission"** - we set out to understand two core components of church life: Family (biblical community - growing in love for one another) and mission (evangelism - growing in love for the lost). We launched the FC-model in April of that year.

In 2018, the theme was **"Keep on Keeping on for the Kingdom"**; knowing that we would face challenges and trials during the second year as a church plant/new Pastor (the first year being sort of like a "honeymoon-phase"). And indeed, we did face challenges. From people leaving our church to realizing the challenges of Family Church, 2018 was a year where we were challenged to "keep on keeping on".

In 2019, the theme was: **"Deeper: His Word. Our Need."** God challenged us to grow as a congregation in reading Scripture. All of the members agreed, "Let's read the New Testament in 2019". Many of you have told me that this is the most consistent you've been in reading the Bible. I hope you will be able to finish strong and complete the New Testament this year.

In 2020, the area that I sense the Lord leading our congregation is growing in a consistent life of prayer. Recently, we began studying the book of Acts on Sundays and we read this description/prescription from the Early Church: *"All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer"* (Acts 1:14).

In 2020, our theme is **"DEVOTED"**. We are seeking, as a church, to grow in our discipline and devotion to Jesus through regularly praying. As followers of Jesus, we should all be praying - we know this. But something to think about is the following:

- Devotion in Prayer Leads to Devotion for People
- God Increases Your Love For Who/What You Pray For...
- Praying more for THC, Hanna Kim, and our Family Churches will produce a greater devotion to these people.

God works through our prayers to accomplish His purposes and we will see that one of His purposes is to unite us, give us a greater love for one another, fill us with a greater love for the lost, and continue to guide us, as a congregation, to a greater love for Him.

BIBLE STUDY

A crucial aspect to our individual and corporate growth is the studying of the Scriptures. On Fridays we experience community and participate in relational evangelism by opening our homes and hearts to VIPs, but we still need to study and apply the truths of Scripture to our life.

In 2018, I taught the first "Living Life Bible Study Class". It was a 13-week course that taught students how to grow spiritually. There was about 10 students who finished the course and when I went to teach this 13-week course again in early 2019, only 4 members signed up. This perplexed me, at the time, because I had heard repeatedly from members of THC that they wanted some type of Bible study.

I brought this up at a Shepherd's Meeting at this time and asked them, "How come more people, including most of you, haven't signed up for this class?" And I received some great feedback. Members (and even Shepherds) were intimidated by how long the class was, the amount of homework, and there remained a lack of understanding of what the class was.

I took all of this feedback and after prayer, I changed the name of the class to FOUNDATION which has the clear purpose of teaching an adequate "foundation" to grow spiritually. I changed the class from 13 weeks to 7. I chose 11 important topics for someone to know so that they could walk out of the class knowing how they could grow spiritually. Lastly, I added something called "Real Life Assignments" which would take some lesson we learned through the lecture and call the student to apply the lesson in "real life" in some way.

I proposed the class, with the new changes in February, and we saw a large increase in this class. I saw many of your hearts grow as you were given instruction from the Scriptures and encouraged to apply these to your life.

In 2020, I hope to teach FOUNDATION 2x and TRANSFORMATION (the 2nd class) one time. TRANSFORMATION is a 13-week class that uses Richard Foster's Celebration of Discipline as a textbook and seeks to give biblical truth and application to things like: meditating and studying Scripture, praying and fasting, singing and rejoicing, and more. I hope you continue to invest in your spiritual growth through "hearing" and "doing".

WHAT'S COMING IN 2020?

1. TRANSFORMATION Bible Study Class: 13 week course studying/applying Spiritual Disciplines. Must have completed FOUNDATION class first in order to take this class.

2. APOLOGETICS Class: Taught by Shepherd Lucas Kao. This class will come around March and is for Christians (who have completed FOUNDATION) and for any VIP to learn why Christianity has good reasons to believe in God's existence and Christ's resurrection.

NEEDS/PRAYER REQUESTS

- For every covenant church member to finish "FOUNDATION" by the end of 2020.
- For God to raise up Teachers from our own congregation to teach our own people.



FAMILY CHURCH

Family Church is the primary ministry of The Home Church. Our hope is for THC to grow primarily through evangelism, not through Christians transferring into our ministry. The purpose of this ministry is to reach the lost (VIPs) and make disciples of Jesus.

This year seemed like our FCs took a major step forward. As we grew in our understanding of the FC model and the importance of FC to our mission, I've witnessed that so many of you were given opportunities to step up and grow in a variety of ways.

This year we saw more members opening up homes to host, we saw many people learn how to work through the difficulties of community, we saw Shepherds filled with more joy as they saw members grow, and I've seen a greater love for VIPs. Reading through Shepherd journals every Thursday has become a true joy for me because I get to see what God has been doing in and through our FCs.

Looking forward to how our FCs will grow in 2020 once we become more DEVOTED to prayer.

NOTABLE FAMILY CHURCH EVENTS

1. Ethiopia FC Multiplies - January

Papa Mitch & Delia's FC multiplied! Chris & Adinai became new Shepherds.

2. FC Missions - Matching Begins - January

Through some donations made to THC, we began to "match" the donation to a FC-missionary. The purpose was to encourage giving to our FC missionaries.

3. House Church Conference in Boston - April

I was able to fly to Boston for the final House Church Pastor's Conference led by Pastor Chai (founder of HC-ministry). I witnessed Pastor Chai's retirement and it left a lasting impression on me on what God can do through someone who is so dedicated to the Great Commission through the local churches. I was able to connect with like-minded Pastors in fellowship and I was able to talk with HC-Pastors who have been doing this ministry for 10, 15, 20 years to learn from them.

4. Shepherd's Get Away - May

We had our first Shepherd's Get Away. All 16 Shepherds were invited to an Airbnb home where we spent Friday evening-Sunday morning together. The purpose was simply to break away from serving and simply be together. Chris spoiled us with amazing food. We played lots of games and allowed for fellowship to organically take place.

5. Ukraine FC Multiplication - June

Abe & Rachel's FC multiplied! Andrew Shim & Ariella Hernandez became new Shepherds.

6. Village Multiplication - July

With the addition of Andrew and Ariella to our Shepherding-ranks, our Shepherd's Meeting now became 16 shepherds. So, we agreed to multiply into two "Villages" of 8 each. Los Angeles, Georgia, and Alaska FC formed Village #1 and Asia, Ethiopia, Korea, and Ukraine FC formed Village #2. The multiplication allows for more intimate sharing to take place in our Shepherd's Meeting.

7. New Finance Team of Shepherds Approved by Members - August

With the Finance Team reducing, I proposed to the Shepherds that I felt that those stewarding the financial direction and decisions of THC should be the spiritual leaders. The Shepherds nominated/voted for 3 members: Chris, Lucas, and Andrew and the covenanted members voted to approve of this decision. The FT collected fund requests from various ministry leaders and met to discuss how to best steward these resources.

8. Shepherd Journaling Begins - August

Shepherds began to weekly journal to me with the praise reports within their FC, ways they wanted me to pray for them, and an opportunity to ask questions and deal with issues taking place in their FCs. The Shepherd Journals have allowed me, as the Lead Pastor, to have a better understanding of the spiritual states of each Shepherd as well as helps me to better train our Shepherds in improving their FCs.

9. Speaking at New Life Fellowship's Shepherd's Retreat - September

Chad Espinoza, Lucas Kao, Elaina Perez, and myself flew out to NLF as speakers for NLF's first in-house Shepherd-retreat. It was quite the honor to speak to the Shepherds of our mentor church that we've learned and benefited so much from. Chad and Lucas shared testimonies. Elaina led a small group. And I taught a main session at the conference.

10. House Church Documentary - October

Chan & Luke from New Life Fellowship came to our church for 1 week as part of a House Church Ministry Project where they sought to interview and capture what God has been doing in and through the members of THC. Every THC Shepherd was interviewed as part of the project and we had a Q&A with Chan Do who is a Village Leader at his church.

11. House Church Training in Chihuahua, Mexico - November

David Pak, Kelly Pak, Andrew Shim, Elaina, and myself flew to Mexico to Pastor Tim & Priscilla Ives' new church plant. The Ives family is the missionary couple that Mexico FC supports. Our church paid for Pastor Tim Ives to go to the 2019 HC Pastors Seminar at NLF and he decided to use the HC model as the type of church plant mission he would use. Our mission was to give some training to his core team of 8-10 members. But something unexpected happened, Pastor Tim connected with Pastor Chris from LightShine Ministry which does ministry to the indigenous people of Mexico. We ended up training close to 30 Pastors and leaders of multiple churches in House Church. All of taught sessions, workshops, shared testimonies, and did Q&As. The leaders were encouraged and we've been hearing positive reports of what God has been doing since. They want us to return again at some point.

2020 AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT

1. More Training and Use of One-on-One Discipleship Material

This is very important, especially for the new Christians that God has been giving to THC. They need to be instructed on how to continue to follow Jesus through applying His teachings to their lives. We need to pray for our VIPs to come to Christ and then pray for God to give us the resources to train them to continue to follow Christ. Currently, Shepherds have been instructed to use "Beginning the Journey" by Ralph Neighbor as a starting point for doing one-on-one discipleship within our ministries.

5. Chihuahua Mission - House Church Training - Pastor Mitchell, Elaina Perez, Andrew Shim, David Pak, and Kelly Pak

THC'S MISSIONS GIVING

There are several ways in which THC gives towards missions:

1. Global Missions - Denominational Giving

In 2019, The Home Church gave 10% of our total tithes/offering/and denominational support back into our denomination Southern Baptist Convention.

We have Hanna Kim, as our one commissioned missionary, but she is not the only missionary we are financially invested in. We also have our FC missionaries, but even beyond that, a portion of our denominational offering goes to the International Missions Board (IMB), which is the largest missionary organization in the world that trains and supports 3,600 missionaries all over the world. Another portion of this offering goes to seeing new churches planted throughout North America, and providing seminary education for the next generation of Christian leaders.

In 2019, THC gave: \$10,404.25

2. Family Church Missionaries

Each Family Church is assigned a missionary in which they are encouraged to pray, remain in contact, and provide some financial support. This means that we are currently supporting 8 different missionaries:

- Yirdaw Tessema - Ethiopia FC
- Chiyon - Georgia FC
- Hanna Kim - Korea FC
- Nathan & Amanda Flickner - Los Angeles FC
- Tim & Priscilla Ives - Mexico FC
- Jacoby Nelson - Ukraine FC

Beginning January of 2019, THC also began to "match" whatever a FC gave to their missionary.

This means that in total, THC gave \$5,366 to our Family Church Missionaries in the past two years.

3. Serving for Elementary VBS & Youth Retreats

Another way to view "missions" is our church's dedication to reaching the next generation of THC'ers currently at Beautiful Church (which is ministry effort to another church). We saw 20 THC members serve in the summer Vacation Bible School led by our own, Joan Lim, as well as 13 volunteers for the Youth Retreat.

Overall, I have been encouraged by the fact that even though we are a small and new church, we have been giving beyond our church. I know God will continue to bless and provide for us as we continually invest in the needs outside of The Home Church.

WHAT'S COMING IN 2020?

1. Summer Missions Team

The THC Finance Team has set aside some money towards a short-term mission team for summer 2020, led by Chris Lee. There are many of you who have expressed interest and this is encouraging.

2. Hanna Kim

Now that we have our first commissioned missionary in Hanna Kim, it's important that we prioritize supporting her. Though we do not currently know how best to support her, we are leaving space in our schedule to see what THC should do in the coming year.

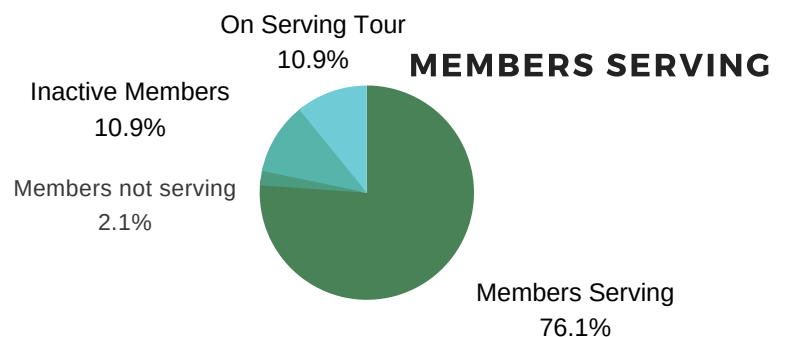
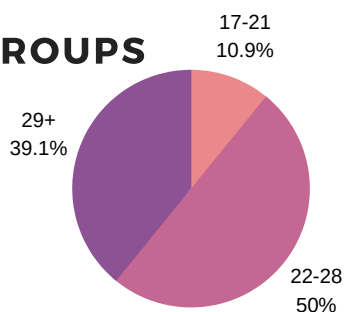

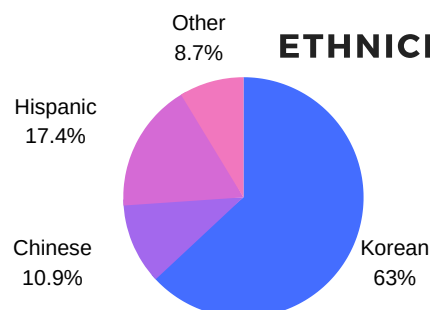

CHURCH MEMBERSHIP CHANGES IN 2019

1. New Testament Reading Plan

THC Members began reading the New Testament in 2019.

2. "Discipleship Pipeline"

Developed to show clarity and give guidance on our "discipleship" process at our church.

3. Serving Tour Improvement

We added a 5th Ministry to the tour (Media Team). We also added a conversation between the Shepherd and the member on the Serving Tour so that the Shepherd can give the opinion/guidance on which ministries would be good for their member to serve in.

4. Finance Team Changes

In August, the THC members voted Andrew Shim, Chris Lee, David Pak, and Lucas Kao to be the team that proposes the 2020 budget and oversees the direction and decision-making of THC funds. The church also accepted Pastor Mitchell's proposal that the Finance Team members should be the Shepherds since they are on the front lines of the ministry at our church and have a greater understanding of our church's mission.

5. Deploying Members to Next Generation Ministries

At last year's Members Meeting, there was great discussion about the need for us to serve in the three "next generation ministries" (THC Children, BC Elementary, & Youth). Many of you heeded this call and are currently serving in these ministries.

2020 AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT

1. Wisdom with Handling Covenanted Members Who Are Not Fulfilling Their Vows

As our church has grown more united in our commitment to our mission of reaching the lost and making disciples, the Shepherds have come across the issue of how to handle covenanted members that are rarely coming to FC or Sunday worship. This is a problem. It is one of the items that the Shepherds will be discussing at our next combined Village Meeting coming up in January.

2. Adapting THC's Mission Statement

Our current mission statement reads:

"A Gospel-Centered Community Changing the City with the Love of Christ for the Glory of God."

It's a great mission statement, but this statement was developed by the previous leadership and before we were doing Family Church. The Shepherds have been discussing how we can improve our mission statement so that it is more aligned with our mission and becomes a way for us to gauge whether or not we are lining up our decisions/actions to our mission.

- Oversees Team Leaders and Shepherds of Family Churches.

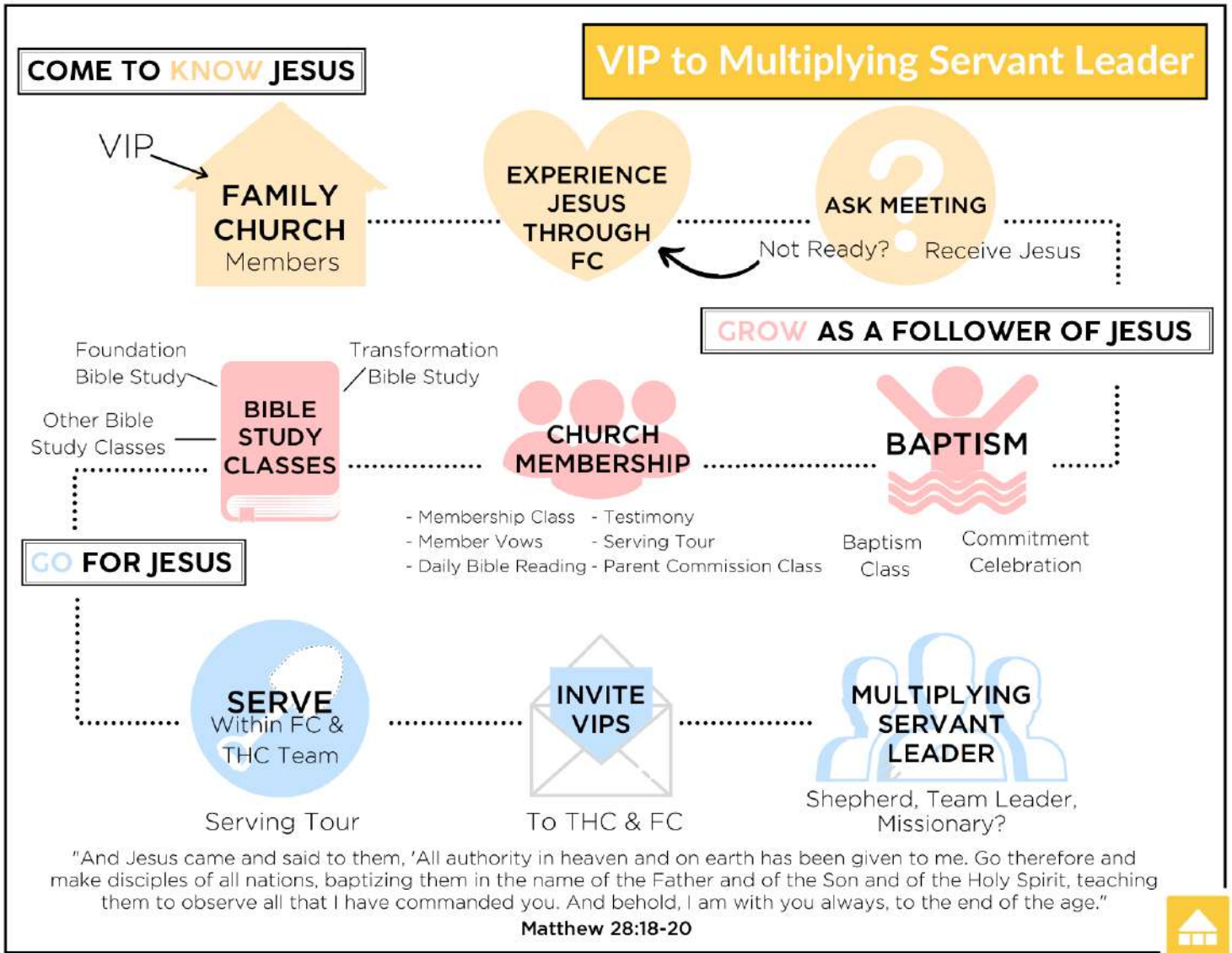
Beyond this broad description I also:

- Communicate frequently with New Life Fellowship in seeing House Church become a movement, as well as continually learning to improve our church.
- Lead a monthly prayer meeting for fellow Rowland Heights Pastors.
- Help our denomination in coaching Los Angeles Church Planters.
- Meet quarterly with other House Church Pastors in California.
- Meet weekly with Pastor John & Danny so that we can work together in our ministries.
- Meet occasionally with Pastor Ko (Senior Pastor of Beautiful Church) to keep the relationship between THC and BC unified for the sake of God's kingdom.
- Meet with engaged and married couples for pre or post marital counseling (PMC).

THREE AREAS OF PERSONAL FOCUS FOR 2020

1. Challenge THC, in love, to grow in regularly praying for THC, Hanna Kim, and their FCs. The theme (DEVOTED) is revolved around the idea of our hearts growing in "devotion" for the things we are praying for.
