Every year that I have been your Pastor I have tried to gather a sense of how the Holy Spirit is leading our congregation. This is formulated into a "theme" for the following year. This theme highlights a specific area for us to grow in. In past years we've had "Family on Mission", "Keep on Keeping On, "Deeper: His Word. Our Need", and most recently "DEVOTED" (In prayer).

This process of identifying a theme comes about as I consider the present state of our church. Thinking through the common conversations I have with you on ways we can grow as a community. I pray. I fast. I seek the counsel of the Shepherds. This process produces a theme for the following year.

If there was a word that encompassed 2020, the word "tired" comes to mind. Many of us are tired. Feeling exhausted. Drained. Devoid of passion.

There are many obvious reasons for this. But what's the remedy for this?

REST.

What does it look like for THC to "rest" in 2021? What does it look like for us to "rest in the gospel"? What does it look like to "rest in His promises"? To "rest together"? To practice "rest" as a spiritual discipline?

What does Jesus mean here:

"Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

- Matthew 11:28-30

I believe 2020 (and the uncertainty of 2021) provide us an opportunity, as a church family, to learn how to "rest".

We will see what "resting" is. We will see how "resting" advances the Gospel. We will see how "resting" allows our souls to be filled with the goodness of God. We will see how "resting" is a form of a soul that trusts God.

Let's learn how to "REST" in 2021.


The classes offered in 2020:

9-week course taught by Pastor Mitchell


3. Surprise Classes?


