

You have done great things.


And I know You will do it again,

Small Group Sermon Study

Prayer: Father, in Jesus' name, through the Holy Spirit, we invite You here to teach and transform us, and lead our time together as we read, discuss, and reflect on Your Word. Amen.

Icebreaker:

Describe your perfect vacation. Where are you? What do you see, smell, feel, and perhaps taste? What kinds of things would you be doing while you are there?

Read Hebrews 11:13-16, 6:19-20, and Colossians 3:1-4 together. From these Scriptures and notes from listening to the sermon, discuss the following:

- Take a minute, then share any words, thoughts, or pictures that come to mind from these verses or the sermon.
- What desires and longings do you have? What breaks your heart in the world today?
- Do you think your desires and longings might point to a "better country, a greater city, a glorious destination"? How does this perspective inform how we should live as Christians?
- "Jesus invites us to trust and hope in Him for eternal life now and forever." What are some practical ways that we can daily trust in the hope Jesus has given us?

Personal Reflection:

- What would it look like for you to believe in God and in His Word without reserve, specifically
 in the promise of a "better country," and not be afraid to put all the weight of your present
 need and eternal future upon it?
- Where is your level of hope in life right now? If you would like to talk to someone and receive prayer, we invite you to contact one of the pastors at heartlandalliance.ca/our-team.
- What will you do with the hope of Heaven? What verse, phrase or word do you need to take with you this week? Share with your group how this will change this next week for you.

Prayer: Almighty God, we ask that You would nourish us as we go through our days. Remind us to, by faith, direct our eyes toward heaven, and to that incomprehensible power manifested at the Last Day by Jesus Christ our Lord, so that in the midst of death we may hope that you will be our Redeemer, and enjoy that redemption which He completed when He rose from the dead. Help us to not doubt that the fruit, which He brought forth by his Spirit, will come also to us, when Christ himself shall come to judge the world. May we thus walk in the fear of Your name, that we may be really gathered among His members, to be made partakers of that glory, which by His death He has won for us. Amen.
