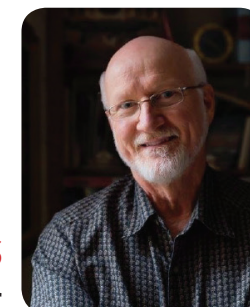
The Love of God
