1. What most impacted you in the message?
2. Talk about your religious experience in the past? Did you have a particular religion that you follow growing up or attempt to be good? Was it important to you or did you do it because you felt you had to? Why is religion often empty to us?
3. Read what Paul said about what he did in the past in verses 4-6. What was his conclusion about his works? Many of us attempt to satisfy a standard in life through our own good works. How does this cause us to compare ourselves to people worse than we are? How does this take us away from Christ's work and become harmful?
4. What does it mean to be positioned in Christ? Do you believe we are outside of salvation as long as we are outside of Christ's offer of salvation? Describe how you jumped from self-righteousness to God-righteousness? How did it impact your security and view of life?
5. Paul concludes in verse 10 by saying, "That I may know Him and the power of His resurrection." What does this expression mean to you? Do you see it differently than religion? How does this view change our perspective of faith?
