## parkview baptist church worship team covenant (2019-2020)

## **Purpose**

The Parkview Baptist Church worship ministry exists to model and facilitate biblical worship in a corporate setting. Our definition of biblical worship is the right response of the believer's heart to God's revealed splendor, sovereignty, and love.

## **Vision**

As a church we should be steadfast and determined for worship that pleases God both in our individual times of worship and in our corporate gatherings. God seeks true worshipers. As we sing, play our instruments, provide technical support, etc. we must worship Him in spirit and truth for the glory of His name and for His fame. Participating in our areas of giftedness and commitment should be an expression of our praise and worship to God. It should demonstrate and inspire those in our gatherings to do the same. It is never about us; it is always about Him and the people we are serving.

We attempt to incorporate a wide variety of musical styles in traditional and contemporary settings. By using a variety of styles, we hope to encourage multiple generations to lift their hearts and voices together in worship, realizing that everyone is compromising somewhat on their personal preferences for the sake of unity.

## **Worship Team Covenant**

This is a covenant between worship team members and our Lord. In following the example of how God deals with us, we will seek to function under the realm of grace and mercy at all times, realizing that none of us are perfect and yet understanding that through Christ, what we need for life and godliness has been abundantly supplied to us through faith. Agreement and adherence to the following commitments (our covenant) are required to be a part of the worship team (vocal, instrumental and tech) of Parkview Baptist Church.

- 1. **Servant Attitude** I commit to develop and demonstrate a servant's attitude and heart, with the understanding that participating on the worship team is an act of privileged service to God and the church body. I will hold this ministry with an "open hand," trusting in the Lord and the leadership of PBC in the scope of my involvement
- 2. **Committed Participation at PBC** I commit to regularly attend the worship services at Parkview Baptist Church (not only when serving), to participate in other aspects of church and body life, as I am able, and to submit myself to the leadership of PBC and their authority.
- 3. **Family Support** If married, I have discussed my involvement in the worship ministry with my spouse and have his or her support concerning my role on the Worship Team.

- 4. **Spiritual Maturity** I understand that serving and leading in worship requires that I have an ongoing relationship with Jesus Christ. I commit to seek a deeper and more dynamic relationship with Jesus Christ as a follower of Him through involvement in opportunities that will encourage and facilitate growth in this relationship and with other believers.
- 5. **Testimony** I understand that the congregation at PBC is looking to me to model a lifestyle of worship. I commit myself to living a consistent lifestyle that is honoring to God.
- 6. **Time Commitment** I commit myself to faithful practice and preparation for involvement in rehearsals and corporate worship times. I agree to be on time and prepared for the start of rehearsal sessions and all scheduled call times. If I am unable to participate or will be late, I will make every effort to contact the leader to whom I am responsible. If I miss a scheduled rehearsal, I understand that the appointed leader of the team will decide if participation in the Sunday service is appropriate.
- 7. **Teamwork and Unity** I commit myself to be accountable to each member of the worship team. I will strive to protect the unity of the team and to share in the responsibilities of the team. I will endeavor to deal with each team member with an attitude of patience and understanding and to have a "teachable spirit."
- 8. **Rehearsals** I understand that rehearsal times should be opportunities to learn new things, to have talents/gifts nurtured, and to have our souls nourished. We are not just learning words, parts, beats, rhythms, or chord changes; we are preparing to lead a portion of the body of Christ in worship. I commit to do my part to make rehearsal times positive and lighthearted and to examine my ego, attitude, and servant's heart before arriving so that team members can enjoy being together and are able to make music for the glory of God.
- 9. **Communication** I understand that open and honest communication is of vital importance to our team. If I have questions or would like to discuss this covenant at any time before, during, or after I complete it, I will contact Curt Payne, Worship Pastor.
