OUR FATHER IN HEAVEN, HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME.

PIPE CLEANER PRAISE

You will need...
Pipe cleaners (from your Prayer Kit)
Your imagination
Other craft items (Optional)

Think about God's creation. What are some of your FAVOURITE things he's made? Is it an animal, a spiky plant, a cool underwater creature...or a minibeast?! Maybe it's a person or food?

Now try to create some things using the pipe cleaners.

Pray "God, Thank you for that you made everything. I especially love _____ (say your favourite things). Thank you that you are powerful, holy God in heaven and you are my loving Father too. Amen"



ROLL AND PRAY

You will need... Dice (from your Prayer Kit)

When we roll a dice we are not in control of the result. Praying isn't really like rolling a dice (because God is in control ALWAYS and he is working all things out for good) but when we pray we should remember that WE are not in control...GOD is. Sometimes things don't work out the way we want but we can always trust that God loves us and will work all things for good if we follow him. We can pray like Jesus - "Your will be done".

Roll the dice and pray for God's will to be done in the following things depending on what number you roll:

- 1 = Salvation for those who don't know God yet
- 2 = Food for the hungry
- 3 = Healing for the sick
- 4 = Homes for the homeless
- 5 = Families for the lonely
- 6 = Joy for those who are sad



STICKY PRAYERS

You will need...
A balloon (from your Prayer Kit)
Tissue paper squares (from your Prayer Kit)

Blow up your balloon and tie it. Rub the balloon against your hair or something woollen so that it becomes all 'static'. Ask an adult to help if you're not sure.

Take the tissue paper squares and hold them close to the static balloon. The tissue paper squares should stick to it! Just like the tissue paper squares, every single one of your prayers STICK to God and matter to him. He LOVES when you ask him for help and for the things you need (daily bread). God loves to answer prayer!

Pray "God, I know you love to look after me and answer my prayers. Please help with _______. Help me to take time to listen to you as well. I know you love to speak to me through prayer, through the Bible and through other Christians too. Help me to hear your voice and know your will. Amen.



GOING, GOING, GONE!

You will need...
Dissolving paper (from your Prayer Kit)
Warm water
Jug or a bowl

Think about something you need to say sorry to God for.

Now think about someone you are struggling to forgive.

Pray "God, I am sorry for the wrong thing I have done. Thank you that, because of Jesus, you have forgiven me completely. Help me to forgive others too. Amen"

Now place the dissolving paper in the warm water and watch it disappear. God has already forgiven and forgotten your sin! THANK YOU, JESUS!



BUBBLE PRAYERS

You will need...
Bubbles (from your Prayer Kit)

Open your pot of bubbles and blow some in the air.

Notice how fun and graceful they are! Bubbles are really fun but eventually they POP and disappear.

Temptations are a bit like these bubbles. A temptation is something that LOOKS and FEELS like it will be good for us but the truth is that they are NOT GOOD for us. They can distract us and lead us away from God's best plan for our life. The good news is that PRAYER HELPS! We can pray to God and he will help us resist temptations.

Pray "God, help me to follow your best plan for my life. Lead me away from temptation and keep me safe. Amen"



SKITTLES PRAYERS

You will need...
Pack of Skittles sweets (from your Prayer Kit)

Open your pack of Skittles and pick ONE sweet out at a time. Pray for different things depending on which colour comes out!

RED - Pray for someone who doesn't know Jesus yet

ORANGE - Pray for a neighbour or school friend

GREEN - Thank God for the good things in your life

YELLOW - Pray for your church leaders

PURPLE - Pray for yourself - maybe you're worried about something or need to say sorry about something
