Scripture Focus: Matthew 21:33-46

Note To Leaders:

Pastor Rob discussed what happens when we let Jesus be the one who takes care of the vineyard of our lives. These questions provide a framework to prompt or foster discussion in your Grid Group. Don't feel you have to use all or any of these questions and you don't have to make it to the end! Use the questions that best fit your group and let discussion flow.

Personal Reflection Questions:

1. What thoughts are still resonating with you from the sermon?
2. What was most encouraging or challenging about this weekend's message?
3. How is the Holy Spirit prompting you to act?

Icebreaker Suggestions:

What is the best thing you've ever grown?

Grid Group Questions:

1. Like the renters of the vineyard, God has given us each "vineyards" to steward well. What vineyards do you oversee?
2. If your role is that of the renter, what changes if you acknowledge who the owner is? What could it look like, practically, for you to allow Jesus to take care of your "vineyards?" What changes would you need to make to step into that more fully? How might the fruit change?
3. In this parable, God's character (as seen in the vineyard owner) was on display. What aspects of God's character were revealed?
